GOING FISHING?

Makin Fisheries

This entire fishery has been created for the angler's enjoyment with 18 clean and landscaped pools and over 500 well maintained and reed fringed permanent swims. 4 pools and 200 swims are reserved for pleasure anglers. Specialist company and corporate events can be organised on request.

The lakes are stocked with 14 different species of fish, including chub, barbel, vast stocks of common, ghost, mirror and koi carp.

Each of the 3 phases of the fishery is served by its own car park and toilet. The only rules which need to be observed are barbless hooks, no keepnets, no dogs, except guide dogs, and no night fishing. Pellets, bloodworm and joker are the only bans. Children must be accompanied at all times. Fishing times are 7.00am until dusk.

Stockton Reservoir

Set in quiet countryside, this 4 acre disused reservoir has been transformed into a superb mixed fishery. 66 large timber platforms ensure comfortable, safe fishing and all are equipped with fixings for umbrellas and banksticks.



A large car park is situated adjacent to the fishery. Water depth varies from 3-8 feet which means the fishery lends itself best to float fishing.

The fishery is stocked with thousands of carp, tench, crucian carp and chub. Pleasure anglers regularly catch over 50lbs in a day. Fishing times are 6.00am until dusk.

Blythe Waters

Blythe Waters offers four attractive lakes, plus a mile stretch of the river Blythe, set in pleasant rolling countryside, established as a popular match venue, it is also well suited to pleasure anglers.

The fishery has good facilities for disabled anglers, particularly on Cherries Pool, which is next to the main car park. Popular with family groups, Blythe Waters offers concessionary tickets.

Stocked with decent sized carp, bream, tench and roach, also perch, silver bream, gudgeon, golden orfe, daddy ruffe, barbel and a few chub, there are no pike on any waters. The club house is open during summer for refreshments and has toilet and shower facilities. Fishing times are 7.00am until dusk.

Earlswood Lakes

Three large reservoirs set in woodland popular with both match and pleasure anglers alike. Engine Pool (open all year) covers 25 acres and has over 100 pegs, 80 of which are large, sturdy timber platforms. Mainly stocked with carp these have now developed rapidly and average over 6lbs. Winning match weights regularly exceed 100lbs with 200lb catches not uncommon.

Anglers should be aware that during summer reservoir levels can fluctuate, usually down, and that the platforms become unusable.

Windmill Pool (open all year) is also 25 acres offering over 50 pegs, the main quarry is bream also roach and perch which can be readily

caught on the pole. Slightly smaller at 20 acres is Terry's Pool, much of which is surrounded by trees, so fishing is limited to just one bank. Fishing is by season permit only and is subject to the traditional close season. Retained as an unmanaged natural fishery the pool contains good stocks of bream, roach, perch, tench, carp and pike. Some anglers tend to target the large carp, but this is a delightful water to float fish where the tench run to 8lbs. Fishing times are 7.30am until dusk.

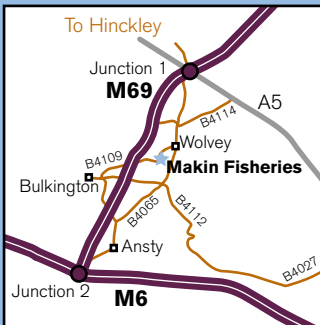

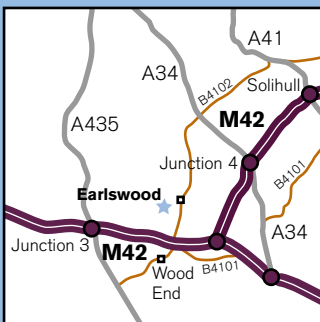

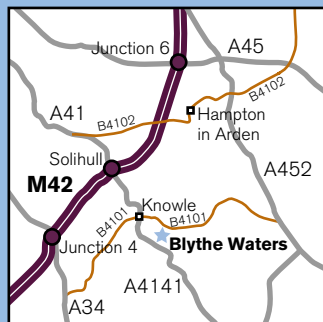
