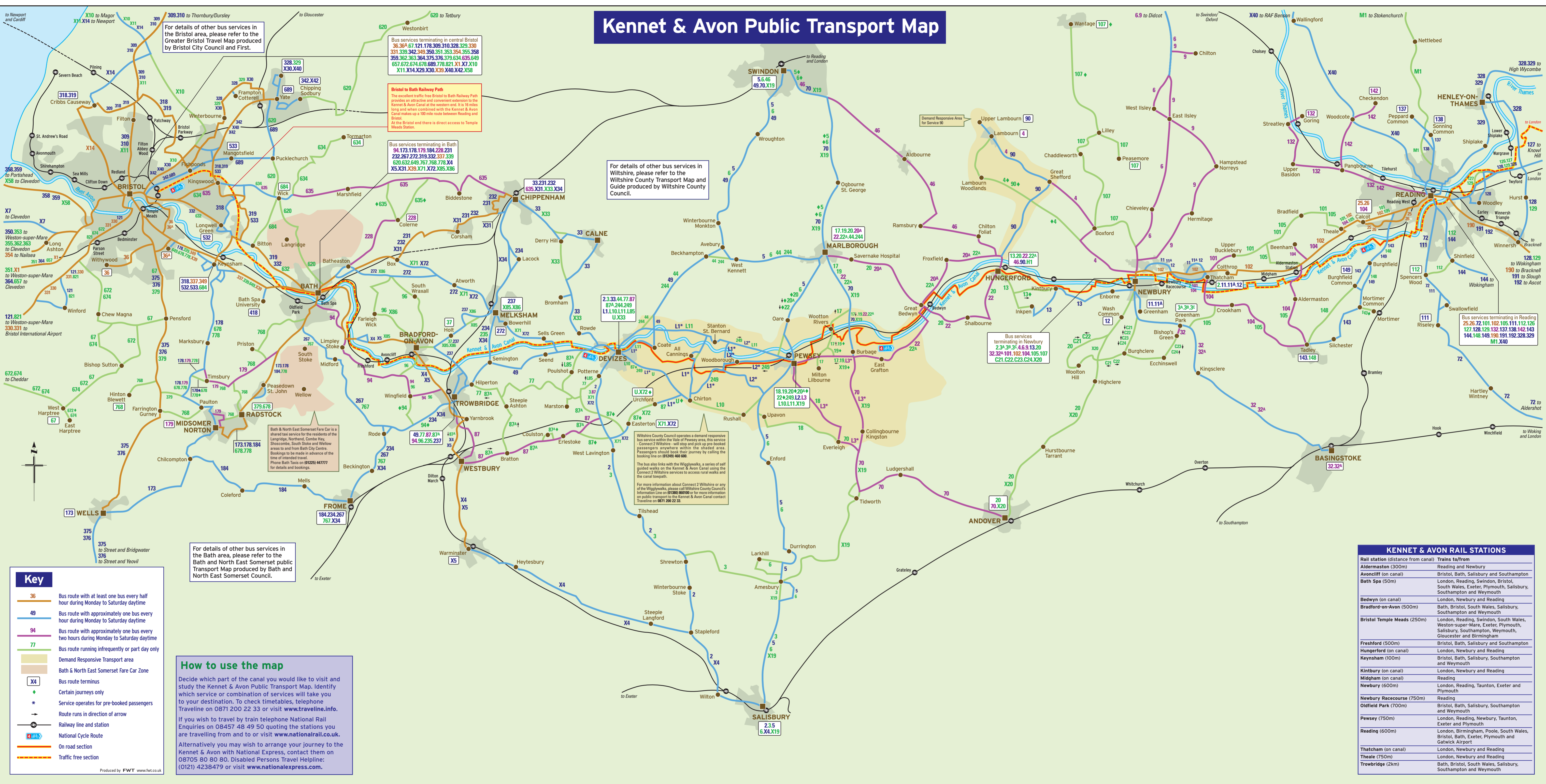


# Kennet & Avon Public Transport Map

**Bristol to Bath Railway Path**  
The excellent traffic free Bristol to Bath Railway Path provides an attractive and convenient extension to the Kennet & Avon Canal at the western end. It is 15 miles long and when combined with the Kennet & Avon Canal makes up a 100 mile route between Reading and Bristol. At the Bristol end there is direct access to Temple Meads Station.
