



## visitor movement....

A network of paths will encourage pedestrian circulation by providing links between the key visitor attractions within the site. This will ensure they experience all of the recreational, cultural, historic and ecological features on offer at Foxton Locks. Links also connect the site to the surrounding towns and countryside via the network of roads, public rights of way and Sustrans cycle routes.

## zoning....

The Foxton Locks site will be divided into three key zones, each with an individual purpose or character. The southern zone will feature as a gateway, the middle zone will house the heritage and learning areas and the northern zone will provide refreshment opportunities.

## points of interest.....

The gateway zone will house the car park, visitor centre, children's playground and camping ground. The heritage and learning zone will house the key cultural, historical and ecological learning areas such as the working inclined plane boat lift, ecology park and historical interpretation. The northern zone will provide a range of waterside pubs, refreshment and activity opportunities.
