

WINTER MOORINGS

Because demand for space at visitor moorings typically falls in winter, some space at visitor moorings is available on a permit basis between November and March. Spaces are not advertised, but allocated on a request basis by the local moorings manager. The price payable per whole month is commensurate with nearby long term moorings.

Requests can be made by email or telephone using the contacts shown on the BW moorings areas map below. Please use email if possible. All BW email addresses follow the format firstname.surname@britishwaterways.co.uk,

Please include the following information in your request:

- Your name and BW customer number
- Your boat index number
- Length of your boat
- List of locations that you would consider for a winter mooring.
- The start and end date for your mooring permit (whole months only)

We cannot guarantee to fulfil all requests and recommend that boaters research winter mooring availability at privately operated sites also.
